Sample Tour Itinerary

Rio de Janeiro - 4 nights

Day 1: Arrive Rio de Janeiro

Upon arrival, you will be met at the airport by our local representative who will escort you to your hotel via private coach. The balance of the day you are free to explore on your own. Rio is nestled between the mountains and the sea. Its magnificent shoreline includes charming bays and beautiful beaches, dotted with islands up and down the coast.

Day 2: Half-day Tour Corcovado

Wed take an amazing morning tour to Corcovado. After a beautiful scenic drive along Rodrigo de Freitas Lagoon, we arrive at the bottom of the Corcovado hill where wed board a comfortable cog train to climb through the Tijuca rainforest to the top of the mountain. Here stands the imposing statue of Christ, the Redeemer, overlooking the city. From the top, discover why Rio is known as the Marvelous Cityd Take the rest of the afternoon to explore this magical city or join the locals on Ipanema or Copacabana beaches.

Day 3: Half-day City Tour and Sugar Loaf Mountain

Today wedl have a panoramic tour to downtown Rio. Stop at the Metropolitan Cathedral which stands like a pyramid 300 feet high. Stroll through traditional Cinelandia Square. Finally, wedl head to Urca to visit the world famous Sugar Loaf Mountain, symbol of the city, located in the middle of Guanabara Bay. Two cable car rides whisk you to the top to enjoy one of the most breathtaking views of the city from over 1100 feet in elevation. Your afternoon is free to enjoy the sights and sounds of this vibrant city.

Day 4: Full-day Tropical Island Tour / Dinner Show

Board a sleek schooner or a fast cruiser and sit back to admire the coastline as we cruise into Sepetiba Bay or Guanabara Bay. Iguassu Falls – 2 nights

Day 4: Flight to Iguassu Falls

Transfer to the airport for your flight to Iguassu Falls. Located on the border of Argentina and Brazil, both sides are a designated UNESCO World Heritage Site and considered one of the most mesmerizing wonders of the continent. Its name means % Water+ and youd soon see why! Spanning heights of 210 . 270 feet, the U-shaped cliff which is 490 x 2300 feet wide carries more water than you can imagine.

Day 5: Tour Iguassu Falls

Your treat today is a walk on the wild side! A 1-mile trail takes you along the river¢ edge, skirting many small waterfalls, right to the base of the biggest falls of all. Creep out onto the catwalk that extends out over the brink of Devil¢ Throat for close-up views of the thundering water. Next, take the elevator to the top for another vantage point.

Day 6: Departure

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight to Rio de Janeiro to connect to your flight home.
